Introduction

Whitletts Victoria Football Club (“The Club”) is a member of the West of Scotland Football League and a registered member of The Scottish Football Association.

The Club will not tolerate unacceptable conduct from its employees, volunteers, committee members, players or supporters at New Voluntary Park or at any other away football stadia.

Unacceptable Conduct Policy

The Club aims to create and maintain an environment where spectators can enjoy the game of football, safe in the knowledge that they are free from all forms of harassment, abuse, unacceptable or disorderly conduct. The Club have a policy document that covers all aspects of unacceptable conduct.

This document records a summary of all preventative and responsive actions that the Club take in dealing with unacceptable conduct. The document will be reviewed on an annual basis, but it will also be updated as action is taken.
